

# Quilted Treasures Pillowcase Pattern

## Fabric Requirements: (Standard Size)

|              |                 |            |
|--------------|-----------------|------------|
| MAIN PIECE   | 27" x 41"       | (3/4 yard) |
| BORDER PIECE | 10" x 41"       | (1/3 yard) |
| ACCENT STRIP | 3" x 41"<br>1/4 | (1/8 yard) |

### Directions:

1. Cut pieces as follows:
  - a. main piece 27" x 41"
  - b. border piece 10" x 41"
  - c. accent strip 3" x 41"
2. Lay 10" border piece face up on table.
3. Lay main piece of pillowcase face up- lined up with border piece.  
All raw edges match at the top.
4. Press the 3" trim piece in half the long way and lay face up on top of the main piece. All raw edges on the top.
5. Roll the main fabric from the bottom up and then fold the border piece up to the top, then pin all of the raw edges together.
6. Stitch  $\frac{1}{2}$  inch along the edge. You now have a tube of fabric. Turn the tube inside out. Your pillowcase is nearly finished with no raw edges and a completed finished edge on the front and back.
7. French Seam finish: With the pillowcase right side out, place wrong sides together and sew the side and bottom using a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam. (1/8")  
Next, turn the pillowcase inside-out, press, and sew the side and bottom again using a  $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam. (1/4")

I used 1/4" seam allowances.

I also skipped the accent strip, but it can dress up the pillowcase if needed.
